



Space to be...

- 2 year old children legally need 2.5 square metres each
- Compared to 3 year old children legally need 2.3 square metres each.
- One toilet is needed for every 10 children plus hand washing facilities



Staffing

- Ratio for 2 – 3 year olds is 1:4 (1 member of staff to every 4 children)
- In school settings, lead staff working directly with 2yr olds, must hold at least a full and relevant level 3 qualification and at least half of all other staff must hold at least a full and relevant level 2 qualification.
- A teacher may have direct contact or oversee the work of the qualified and unqualified staff.
- The Early Years lead /teacher should have at least two years' experience of working in an early years setting, or have at least two years' other suitable experience



2yr Integrated Review

- Each child should have a 2 year progress check (2 year development summary) between the age of 2 and 2 ½ .
- Two year integrated review with the child's Health Visitor will take place between the ages of 2 and 2 ½.
- As from September 2015 the 2 year Integrated Review will take place in the child's early years setting.
- Each setting will be allocated their own Health Visitor.

Sleep Spaces

- Children will need a quiet space to sleep.
- Day beds/mats and bedding will be needed.
- Safe Sleep guidance from the 'Lullaby Trust' can provide training (email office@lullabytrust.org.uk)
- Comforters/blankets/dummies
- Sleep monitoring forms
- Laundry





Nappies and Toilet Training

Consider the environment - privacy verses safeguarding.

- Induction of family – favourite rhymes, toys, how changing is at home
- Increased number of children in nappies.
- Nappy changing areas./environment
- Staffing. Attachment to main carer /keyworker
- Resources

Individual baskets for each child

Bags with changes of clothes in

Nappies/creams/wipes provided from home

All changes witnessed and signed for



Care Files-why is recording important?

- Each key group has a care file
- Each child has their own section with all care forms completed
- These are then filed into each of their personal files.
- Communication with parents



EYFS

- Focus on the 3 Prime Areas of the EYFS – these are the Statutory Requirement
- Cross reference the planning against all 7 areas of the Curriculum
- Weekly Planning meetings take place
- Individual ‘ Learning Journey’s’ are completed for each child. (Tapestry)
- Children’s progress is recorded. – Entry Level, Base Line, Mid-Point and End Point.

FUNDING



2 year EEE Funding is available for children who meet a certain criteria

Children entitled to 15 hours per week for 38 weeks - this cannot be topped up - unlike 3 year old EEE

This funding can be stretched across the year e.g - 2 days over 48 weeks

You are not entitled to claim Pupil Premium for 2 year olds

Paperwork is submitted via the census

You need to keep evidence of entitlement for each child and have a clear audit trail.

There is now a 2 year checker so that you can check eligibility of children

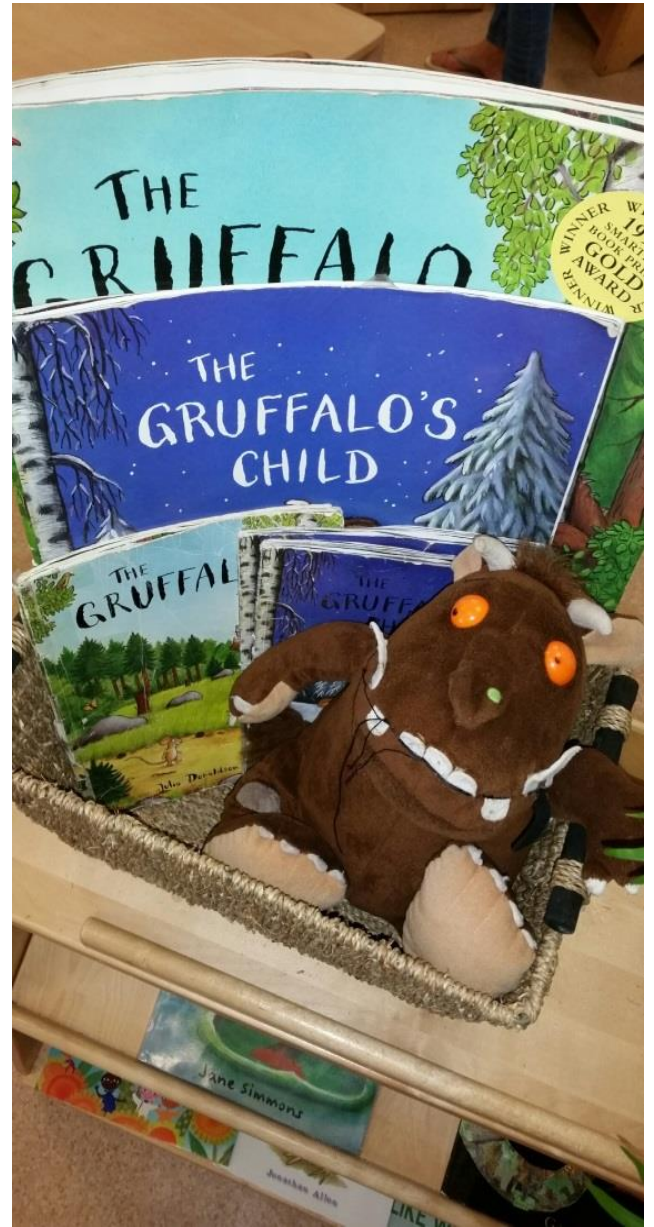
